The sector deals with complex customs legislation and has a need to demonstrate competence in compliance with customs controls and procedures. Clients require their international supply chain to be fully secure, efficient and compliant.

Key responsibilities are likely to include shipment bookings, creating appropriate documents, liaison with carriers, ports and handling agents, sales quotations, customer service, invoicing and financial procedures.
